

Welcome to the 23rd annual North Hill Thanksgiving U18 Curling Bonspiel

The North Hill Curling Club is excited to host this event which is now on the Alberta Junior Curling Tour!

16 teams are participating (8 women's and 8 men's) resulting in 4 pools of 4 teams; each team will play 3 round robin games on Saturday. On Sunday, the top 2 teams in each pool will play in the championship playoffs, while the 3rd & 4th place teams will play in the consolation playoffs.

- games are 8 ends.; Ties in the round robin will remain a tie and both teams earn 1 point. Winning team earns 2 points. Ties in the playoffs will go to an extra end.
- 5 rock rule is in effect
- hammer will be determined by a last stone draw immediately following your practice. If both teams cover pin or miss house a coin toss determines hammer.
- 4th end breaks – 3 minutes; **snacks must be consumed in the viewing area**
- each team is allowed 2 self-timed 1 minute timeouts **and 1 timeout per extra end.**

Teams will be ranked for the play-offs following round robin play. 2-way ties will be broken by head to head record; 3-way ties will be broken using a shootout which will take place immediately after the 3rd game. Each member of the team will throw a stone for measurement to the pin. Sweeping is allowed. It is the responsibility of each team to measure their own stones. Before a stone is removed, measurements should be confirmed by a North Hill representative. The maximum measurement for stones not reaching the house is 72 inches. The best 3 of 4 measurements will be totalled to determine a team's overall score.

Pre-game practice will consist of each player throwing 1 rock up and 1 rock back.

All curlers **must use WCF approved brush heads** for this event
