The North Hill Curling Club (the "NHCC" or the "Club") has been informed that a total of 5 (five) Members have now tested positive for COVID-19 that were curling in the early draw of Monday October 26th. All of these curlers were on the same sheet of ice. This number includes the original member who tested positive as reported in the Coronavirus Bulletin dated October 29, 2020. All of these members are isolating at home and none of them have returned to NHCC since October 26th. The remaining people on that sheet have tested negative. They too have not returned to NHCC as per COVID-19 Protocols.

We sincerely wish for the speedy recovery of all of these individuals.

The Management and Board of Directors of the NHCC remain committed to the health and safety of its curlers and employees and have put in place a number of protocols to mitigate transmission of COVID-19. It is essential that all people coming into the facility comply with posted rules regarding the use of masks and physical distancing. We reiterate that anyone experiencing any symptoms should stay at home and contact health authorities.
