The family were tested on Tuesday, were advised earlier today by Alberta Health Services ("AHS").

Members of this family participated in the Friday Junior Program this past Friday, October 30, 2020 (4:30 time slot). This is the last time the family had been in our facility and they had no symptoms at that time. The entire family is isolating at home.

The family were tested because of a close contact one member had at their school.

We sincerely wish for a speedy recovery of the individuals affected.

The Management and Board of Directors of the NHCC remain committed to the health and safety of its curlers and employees and have put in place a number of protocols to mitigate transmission of COVID-19. It is essential that all people coming into the facility comply with posted rules regarding the use of masks and physical distancing. We reiterate that anyone experiencing any symptoms should stay at home and contact health authorities.
